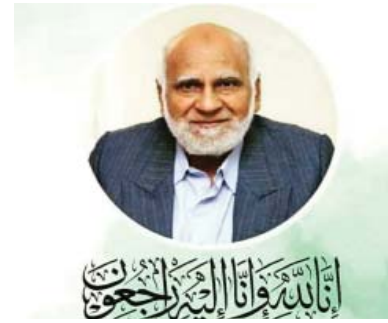


The Loving Memory of Prof. Dr. Muhammad Sarwar

Prof Dr. Muhammad Sarwar among the most senior and respectable General Surgeon of Pakistan. 1940-2020.

Born in Allahabad, Dr Sarwar came to Karachi for 'sightseeing' in 1948 and stayed in Karachi. He got admission in Dow Medical College and completed his M.B.,B.S. from the same college. He was instrumental in forming Pakistan's first student union, the Democratic Students Federation. He served as the DSF's President and Secretary-General before the Mohammad Ali Bogra government banned it in 1954. He was also the driving force behind the Inter-Collegiate Body (ICB) comprising student unions in different colleges and the All Pakistan Students Organisation (APSO), established in 1953.

Dr Sarwar spearheaded the January 8, 1953 'Demands Day' that spelled out the needs of students, including the establishment of a fullfledged University Campus (now it is known Karachi University). He cleared his fellowship examination from College of Physicians and Surgeons Pakistan with flying colors.

Later he joined Dow Medical College, Surgical Faculty and became Professor of Surgery. After his retirement he joined Hamdard University as Professor of Surgery and Dean, Faculty of Health and Medical Sciences.

He served Sir Syed University for several years. He did lot of work for training and research work for medical students and junior doctors.

He has also been associated with Liaquat College of Medicine & Dentistry as Professor of Surgery for several years and then Controller of Examination till his last.

He worked as President, Society of Surgeons Pakistan, Karachi Chapter for several years. His services for medical faculty uncountable. He was a practicing surgeon till before his final illness. He left his wife and three childrens.
